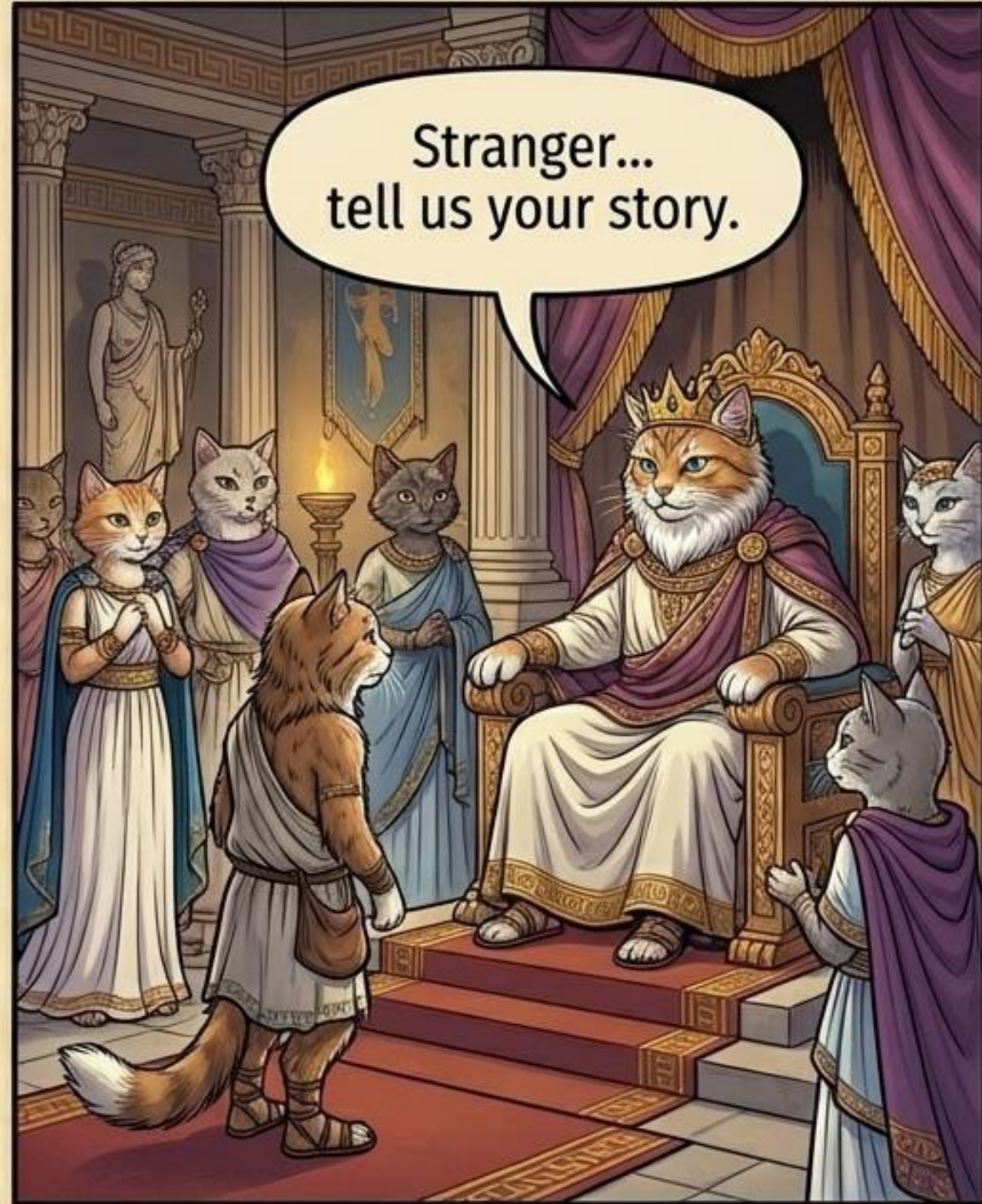

He seized two of my companions in his fist, and smashed them on the ground like puppy dogs.



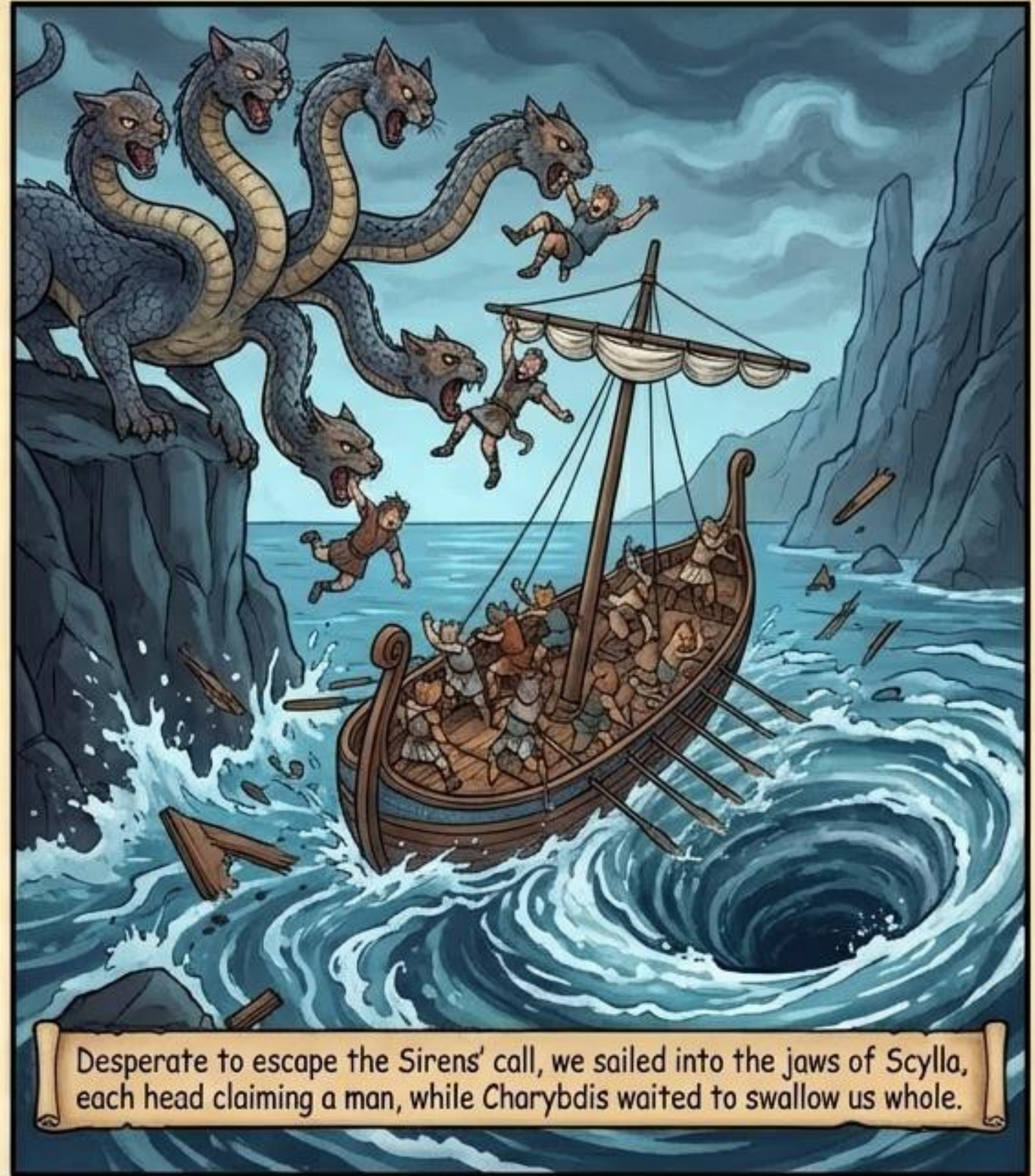

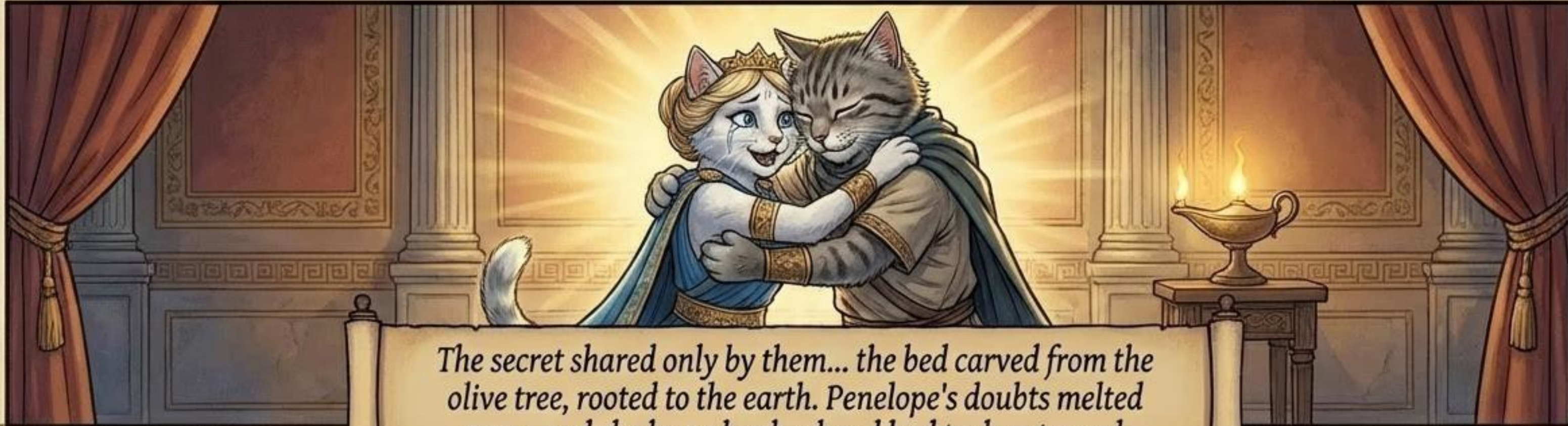

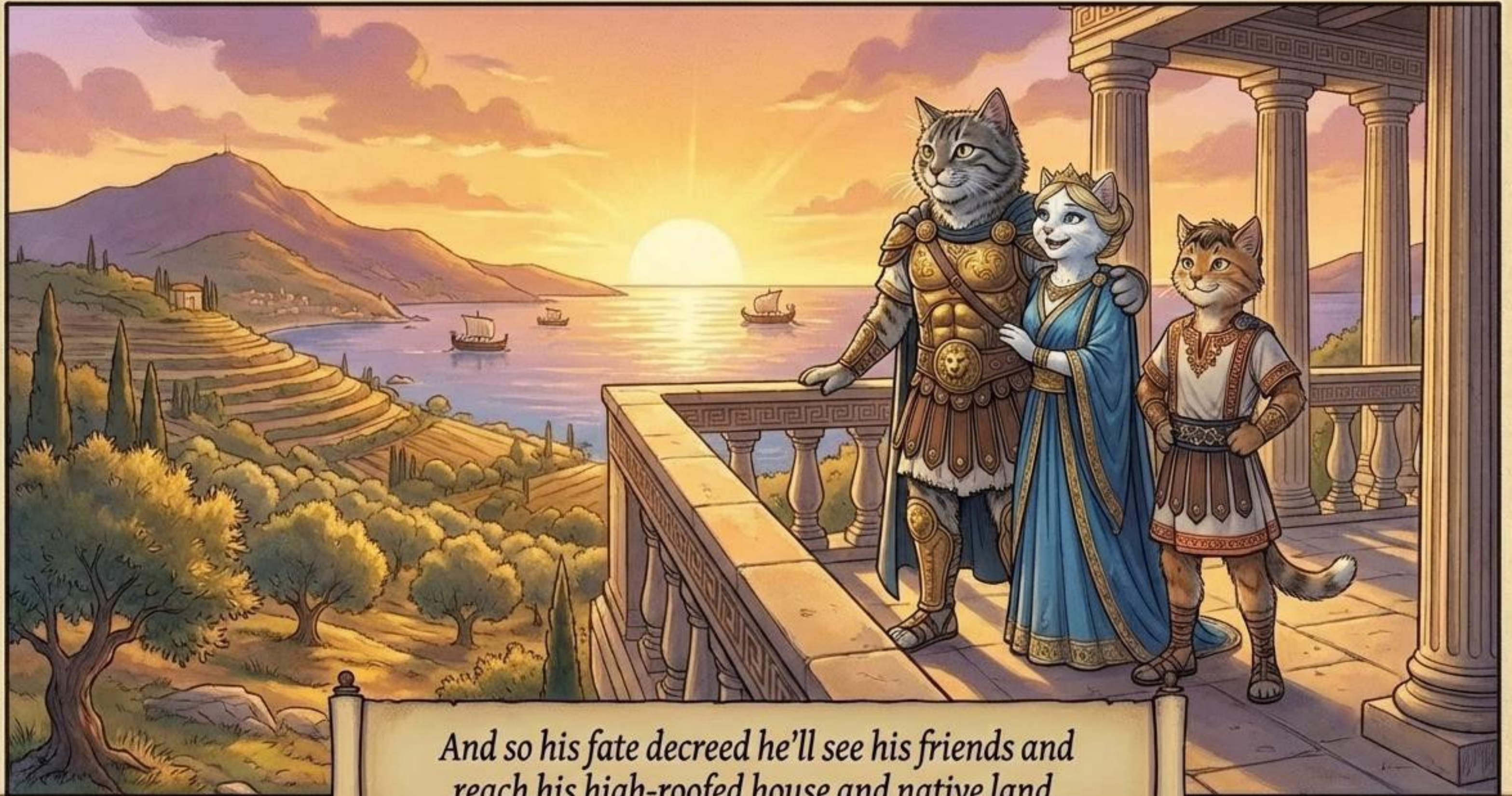


THE SECRET OF THE BED
